POSSUM CONTROL

As you are aware, KB Environmental Services has been contracted by TBfree New Zealand Limited to undertake pest control work for possums in the Ruapehu District. The work undertaken is to reduce bovine Tb vectors in this area.

The operation (see attached map) is known as:

- Ruapehu South GS3 and GS4

Control methods scheduled for use on this land consist of Feratox (Cyanide) and Pestoff (Brodifacoum) in bait stations, Feratox (Cyanide) in bait bags and trapping.

Commencement of treatment has started and we now expect to be completed by 31 August 2017.

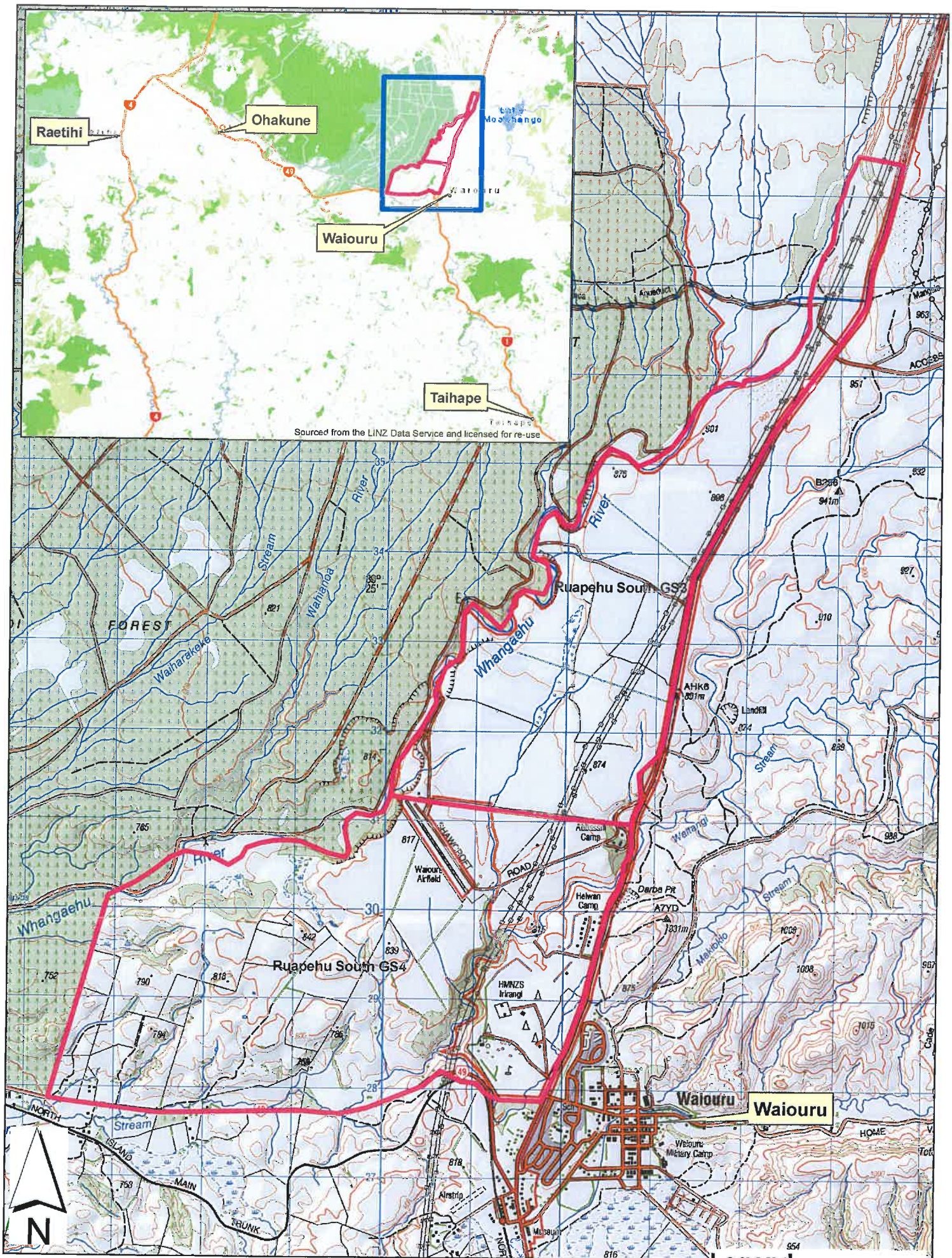
The work will be carried out in accordance with all relevant legislation with appropriate consent/approvals obtained.
