

BATTLE FOR OUR BIRDS UPDATE AS AT 26 AUGUST

The attached Battle for our Birds schedule of operations has been updated based on August rodent tracking results.

Main changes are;

- Blue Mountains cancelled; rats numbers have dropped to very low levels.
- Waikaia on hold; rats numbers have dropped to low levels.
- Eglinton, Kepler, lower Hollyford, Beresford Range, Haast true left, Te Maruia and Matukituki confirmed. Rodents have passed trigger levels at these sites.
