



HUNTING BALLOTS

1. TAHR BALLOT 2009 - Adams & Hooker/Landsborough Wilderness areas.

The Himalayan Tahr Control Plan provides for helicopter approved operations to recreational hunters at specific sites in the above areas for the purpose of wild animal control, during the period of the 25th April 2009 to the 17th July 2009 (Both dates inclusive). Hunters wishing to obtain permits for these areas should log onto the DOC website to download the information package and permit application form: www.doc.govt.nz/haasttahrballot. Alternatively hunters can ring 03 750 0809 or email haastvc@doc.govt.nz and provide credit card details. The application form must be posted to DOC, PO Box 50, Haast 7844, Attn Tahr Ballot. Completed applications must be received by 4pm on February 13th 2009 to be included in the ballot draw.

2. GREATER WELLINGTON REGIONAL COUNCIL BALLOTS

(i) WAINUIOMATA & ORONGORONO WATER CATCHMENTS

These catchments are normally closed to the public. The hunting will play a part in controlling animals in the water collection area and will help to improve water quality. Ten hunting blocks are available for four periods of five days. To enter the ballot, hunters (only one form per person) should obtain an information pack (including a ballot entry from) by sending a cheque, \$5 nonrefundable, to 'Wainuiomata Hunting Ballot', Greater Wellington, PO Box 40847, Upper Hutt. Those successful in the ballot will be required to pay a further fee of \$20 for each five-day period. Ballot entries must be received by 12 noon, on Monday February 16th 2009. The ballots will be held on Wednesday February 18th 2009. The winners of the ballots will be notified by mail on Friday February 20th 2009. For further queries contact Joanne Clifford-Marsh on 04 526 3144 or ioanne.clifford-marsh@gw.govt.nz

(ii) EAST HARBOUR REGIONAL PARK – DEER HUNTING

The hunting will play a part in controlling animals in the park, and also provide an opportunity for recreational deer hunting with a designated deer hunting area. Hunting of deer is available for nine periods of three days each, with one balloted hunter and a nominated partner allowed in the designated area at any given time. To enter the ballot, hunters (only one form per person) should obtain an information pack (including a ballot entry form) by sending a cheque, \$5 non-refundable, to 'East Harbour Deer Hunting Ballot', Greater Wellington, PO Box 40847, Upper Hutt. Ballot entries must be received by 12 noon, on Monday February 16th 2009. The ballots will be held on Wednesday February 18th

2009. The winners of the ballots will be notified by mail on Friday February 20th 2009. For further queries contact Joanne Clifford-Marsh on 04 526 3144 or email her on joanne.clifford-marsh@gw.govt.nz

(iii) MANAGED PIG HUNTING

Greater Wellington regional Council is giving the opportunity for members of the public to undertake pig hunting in the East Harbour Regional Park. Permits will be issued for a fivemonth period each year - 1 May to 30 September (dates inclusive). There will be no restriction on the numbers of permits issued. The hunting will play a part in controlling animals in the park, and also provide an opportunity for the recreational hunting of pigs within designated hunting areas in the Northern Forest Block. Permits for non-firearm use will be issued on application. Dog registration number microchip numbers are required prior to permits being issued (maximum of three dogs). Permits can be obtained by contacting Joanne Clifford-Marsh on 04 526 4133 or at Greater Wellington's Upper Hutt Depot, Greater Wellington, PO Box 40847, Upper Hutt or email Joanne joanne.clifford-marsh@gw.govt.nz

POISONING OPERATION and AN OPPORTUNITY TO HAVE YOUR SAY NORTH BLOCK – AORANGI STATE FOREST PARK 7,544 hectares using 1080 from May 2009

Enclosed in the newsletter to the branches in the Greater Wellington area and available electronically on request.

Greater Wellington Regional Council are seeking a consensus or compromise between the funders and those with an interest in the area. The options are as follows:

Option 1 – treat the complete area with the use of deer repellent 1080 baits at an additional cost of \$74,800; Option 2 – treat only the Aorangi Forest Park area with deer repellent 1080 baits at an additional cost of \$59,000; Option 3 – treat only a potion of the areas with deer repellent which includes the best access and hunting areas

(Tauanui catchment) at an additional cost of \$38,300. Option 4 – treat complete area without the use of deer repellent on 1080 baits resulting in no additional cost. Range Keys

Any person who wishes to have a range gate key for the private use of our range must be a CURRENT FINANCIAL MEMBER of the Branch and must obtain a key from Hamills, Outdoorsman HQ or Serious Shooters, Amohia St, at a cost of \$20.00 per year. Your membership card must be produced at the time of key purchase. Keys may not be lent or passed on to other persons, whether they are members or not. Non-Members can only enter the Range if accompanied by a current Financial Member. Any use of the range by non-members requires prior approval of the committee executive.
